The Vortex

Little Five Points and Midtown The 20-foot laughing skull outside of the Vortex's Little Five Points location has been a fixture of Atlanta's landscape since 1995. Known for its general irreverence, the Vortex is a can't-miss Atlanta destination. When it comes to ordering food, think gluttonous. They're famous for their over-the-top "Bypass Burgers," (anything beyond a "Single Bypass Burger" comes with restrictions) but a regular (plain) burger is still delicious.
